Tactical Time-Out Pearls

3.0-CF/PL-23

Security/Tactical:	Brief the local security situation and updates to the tactical situation
Security:	Assess and ensure the security of the local environment, identifying any potential threats to the team.
Tactical Situation Update:	Provide an updated overview of the current immediate tactical situation, including objectives, enemy movements, and any changes or developments that may impact the operation.
Operational:	Brief the operational and evacuation situation
Adjacent activity:	What is going on in the area around the team that they should be aware of?
Evacuation Plan:	Establish procedures for patient evacuation. Which patient go's first. What are the evacuation platforms there constraints.
Contingencies:	Brief all contingency plans
Blow out Plan:	Plan if we have to leave in the next 5 mins? Is everything packed and ready?
Soft Compromise:	Plan for patient and resource allocation in case of compromised security
More Patients:	Prepare for the possibility of receiving additional patients, ensuring that the necessary resources and personnel are available to accommodate the increased workload.
Mass Casualty:	Develop strategies to handle a large number of casualties, including triage procedures, resources, and coordination with external support.
Shift Change:	Team Administrative tasks
Team Rest Cycle:	Determine the schedule for rest and rotation of medical personnel, ensuring that team members are adequately rested and able to perform at their best throughout the operation.
Supply Plan:	Address shortages of essential resources by identifying alternative sources, implementing rationing measures, or requesting additional support.

Patient Update:	Brief on the status and condition of each patient using abbreviated SIT-VD Mnemonic and also the plan for nursing care:
Patient #1	Stable or Unstable

	Drugs and fluids (The things that you cant see)
	Nursing care plan
Treatment plan:	Outline the next 3 specific actions and interventions required for each patient to ensuring that the appropriate medical procedures are planned and executed.
Red Flags:	Highlight any critical indicators to start a intervention or the get extra advice.
Essential Supplies:	Confirm the availability and readiness of necessary medical equipment and supplies, ensuring that the team is adequately equipped to provide the care necessary.
